



Trail Notes As of Late-November 2024: **Green Trail:** These trails are not blazed but are largely old woods roads and are clear enough to be easy to follow, as least in daylight. Beyond the western-most junction with the white trail, the green trail becomes a stream, at least in wet times, peters out and is blocked by various fallen trees. **Orange Trail:** This trail is not blazed but is fairly well-established. **Red (Oak) Trail:** This trail has been cleared but is not blazed. There is red surveyors tape along most of it. Since it's a new trail it's not as easy to follow as the green and orange trails. **Yellow Trail:** This trail has been cleared and blazed with painted yellow squares on trees. As it's a new trail, it's not as easy to follow as the green and orange trails, but is used regularly so it's fairly well-trodden. **White Trail:** This trail has been cleared and is blazed with painted white circles on trees, except for the section that connects from the western junction with the yellow trail up to the green trail. That section has been cleared but not blazed. As it's a new trail, it's not as easy to follow as the green and orange trails, but it is used regularly so it's fairly well-trodden. **Purple Trail:** This trail has been cleared but is not blazed. There is red surveyors tape along most of it. Since it's a new trail it's not as easy to follow as the green and orange trails.
